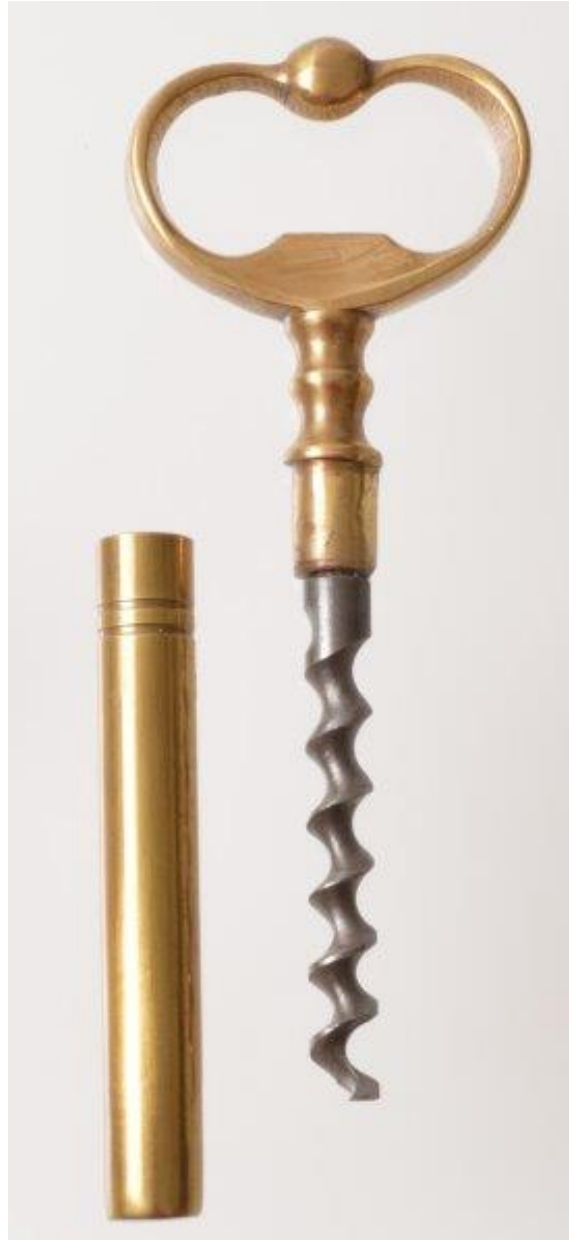


KDD000 José Manuel Cotrina is the owner of the Spanish jewellery manufacturing company ENYEL in Madrid.

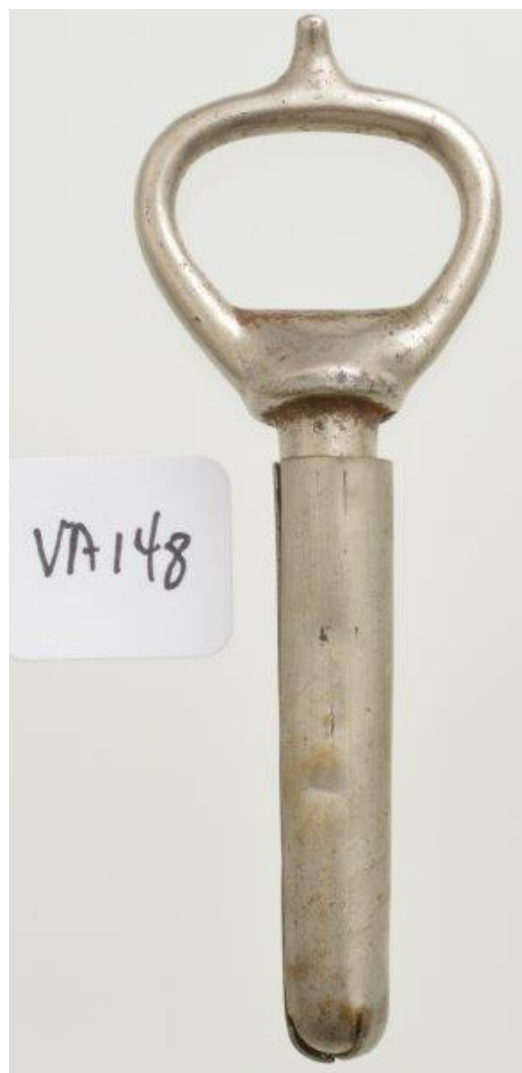

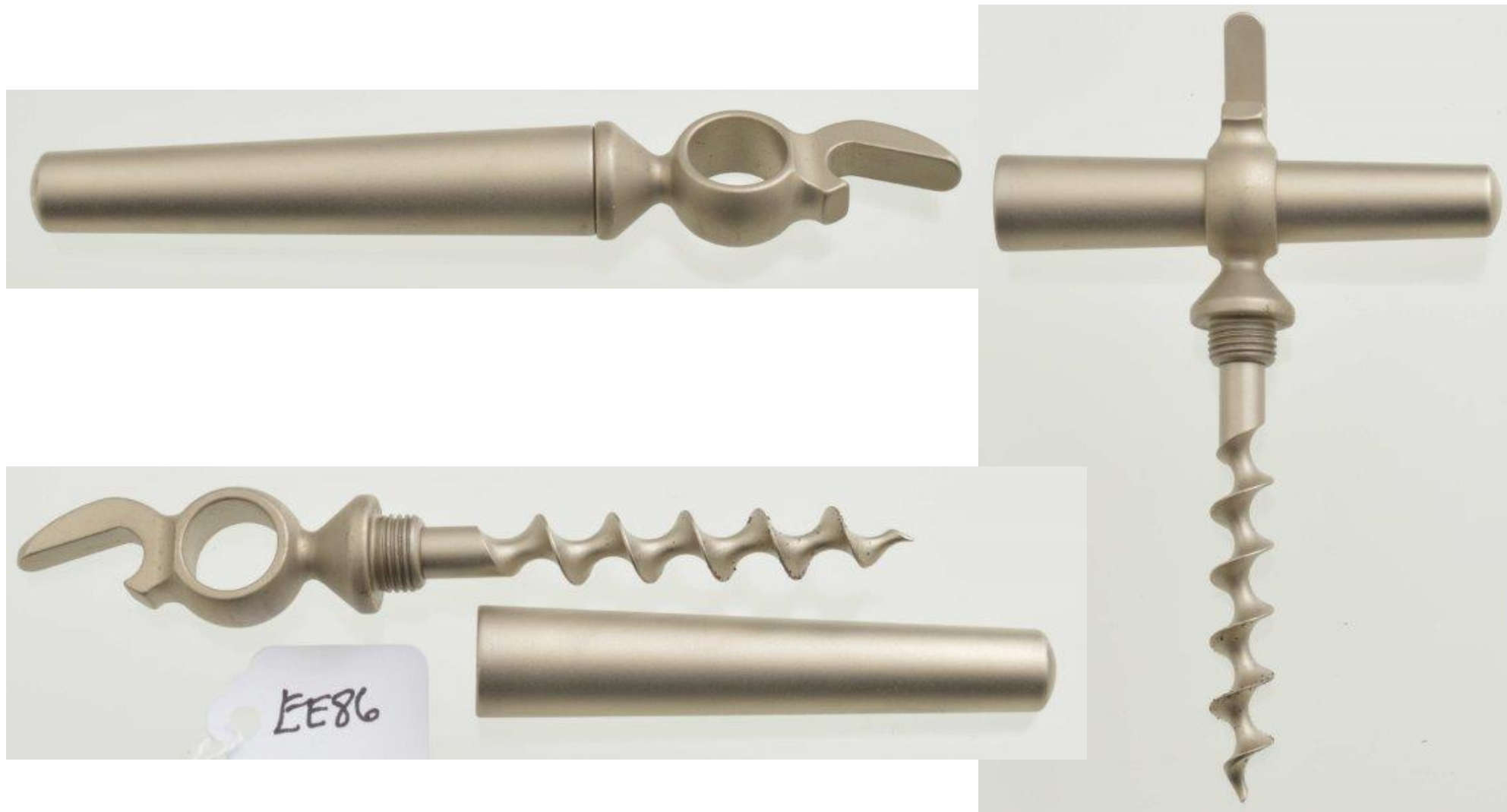
