Hammesfahr Patent

On January 20, 1897 Gottlieb Hammesfahr of Solingen, Germany obtained German Patent No. 93,264. for his rather ingenious method of making a knife with a long corkscrew. The worm pivots on a pin horizontally 180° on one half of the upper arm. It is then lifted into position. Several of these are shown on the following pages.

Also U. S. Patent No. 610,530 of September 13, 1898 and British Patent No. 19,540 of August 24, 1897.
