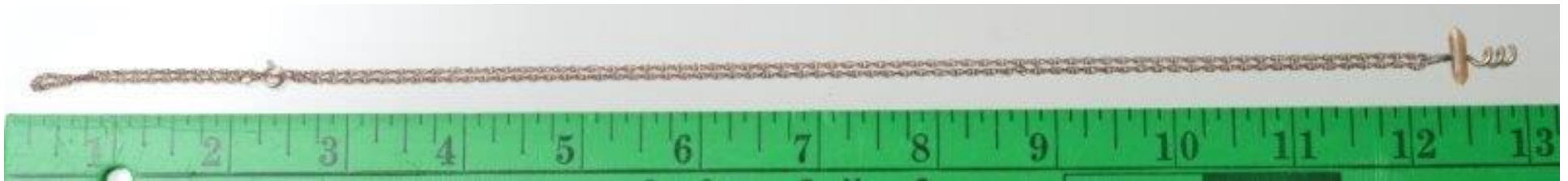

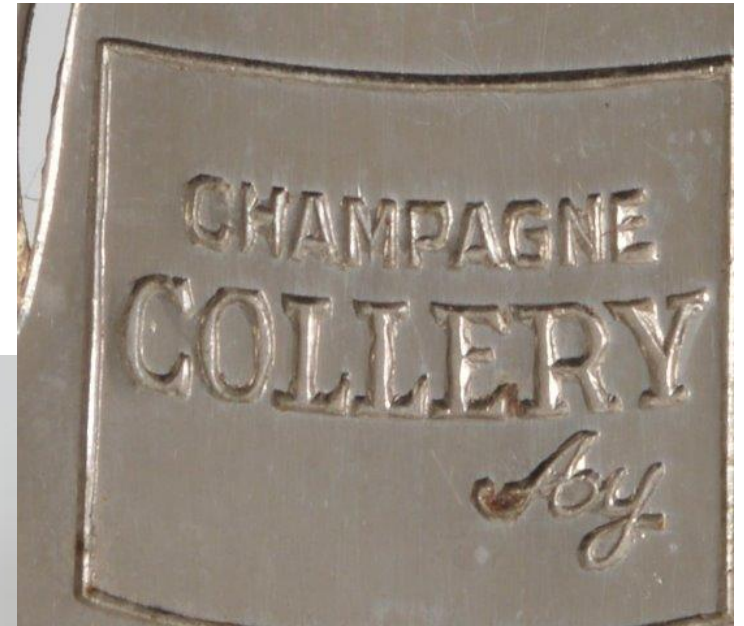

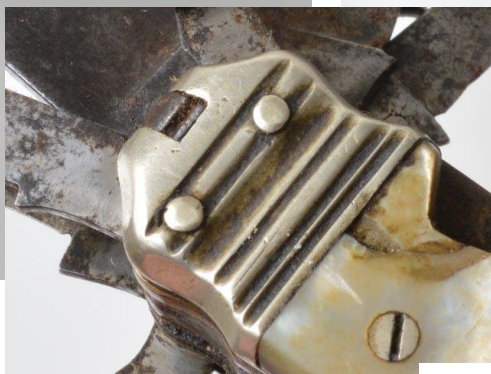

Hammesfahr Patent

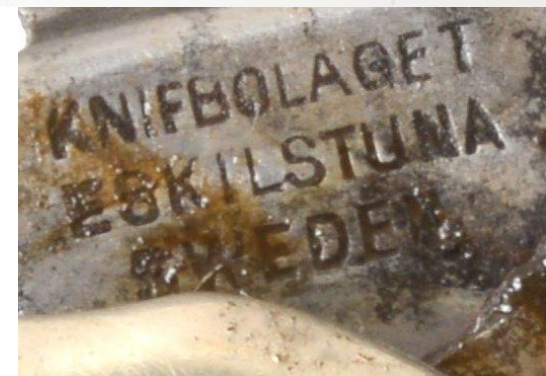
On January 20, 1897 Gottlieb Hammesfahr of Solingen, Germany obtained German Patent No. 93,264. for his rather ingenious method of making a knife with a long corkscrew. The worm pivots on a pin horizontally 180° on one half of the upper arm. It is then lifted into position. Several of these are shown on the following pages.

Also U. S. Patent No.. 610,530 of September 13, 1898 and British Patent No. 19,540 of August 24, 1897.



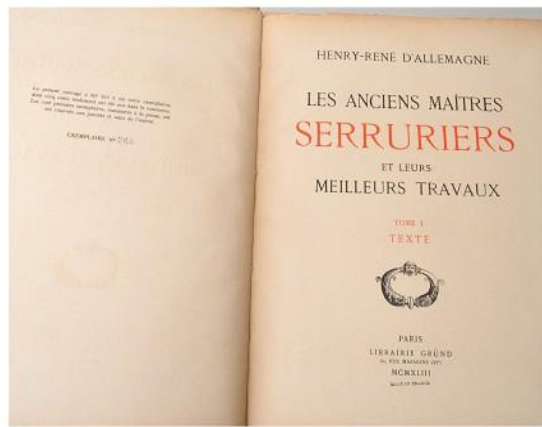
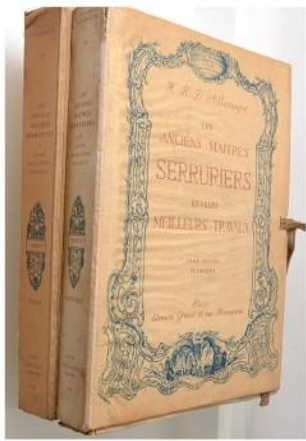
JN078 Swedish Hammesfahr patent knife marked EMIL OLSSON ESKILSTUNA.

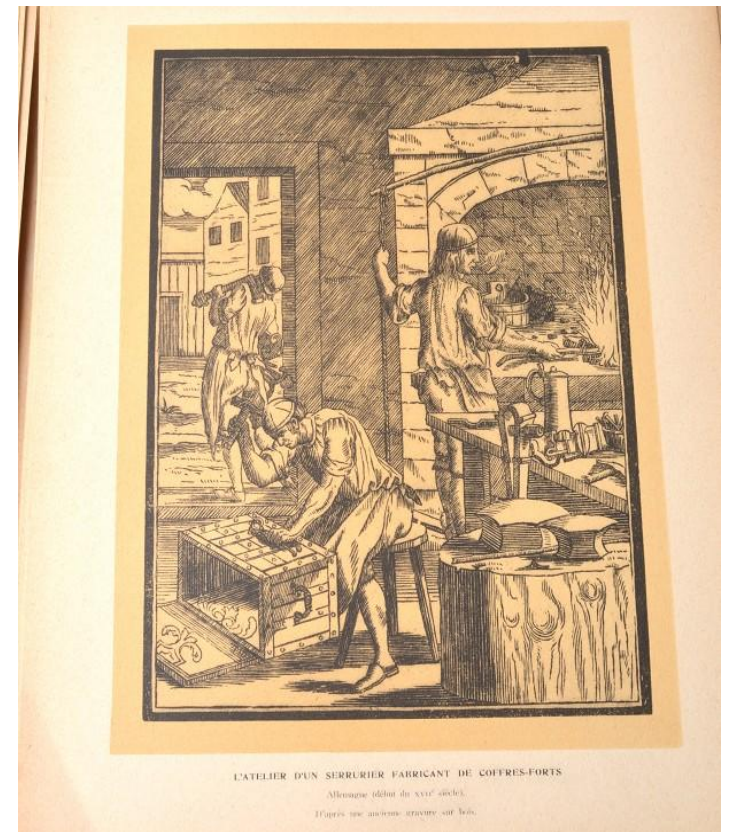

Les Anciens Maitres Serruriers Et Leurs Meilleurs Travaux by Henri-Rene D'Allemagne, Two Volumes. Published in 1943 by Librairie Grand, Paris. Volume 1 presents a history of the Parisian Ironworkers with chapters on grilles, staircases, locks, keys, tool, furniture, and more. Volume 2 has more than 100 illustrations and 167 folio plates with an index to plates. A superb French reference work for anyone researching early iron objects. Bert Giulian used these extensively for research for his book on 18th Century corkscrews. The binding on Volume 1 is intact. Many of the pages are uncut. The pages in Volume 2 are loose. Overall condition is fair. The weight for the two volume set is nine pounds. Shipping cost: USA by media mail \$18. Europe \$125. Others inquire.
