Rack and Pinion Corkscrews - In a rack and pinion gear arrangement, the pinion meshes with a rack with teeth which converts rotary motion to reciprocating motion. In rack and pinion automobile steering, for example, the steering wheel column leads to a pinion gear which engages with a rack which eventually leads to the steering arms and wheels. When the steering wheel is turned to the right or left, the pinion rotates on the rack moving it right or left.

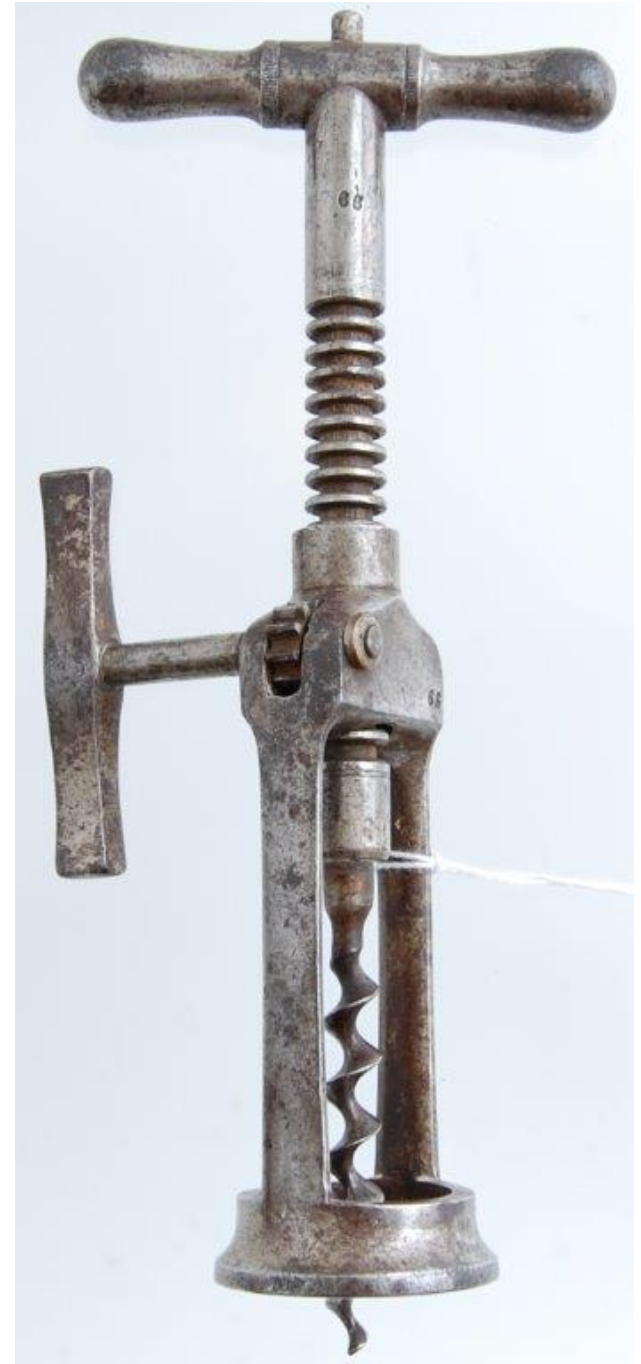
Long before Henry Ford began mass producing Model T's, corkscrews had been produced with racks and pinions. T-handles with racks with teeth on shafts with barrels or frames and engaging side handle gears were the first "rack and pinion" corkscrews.

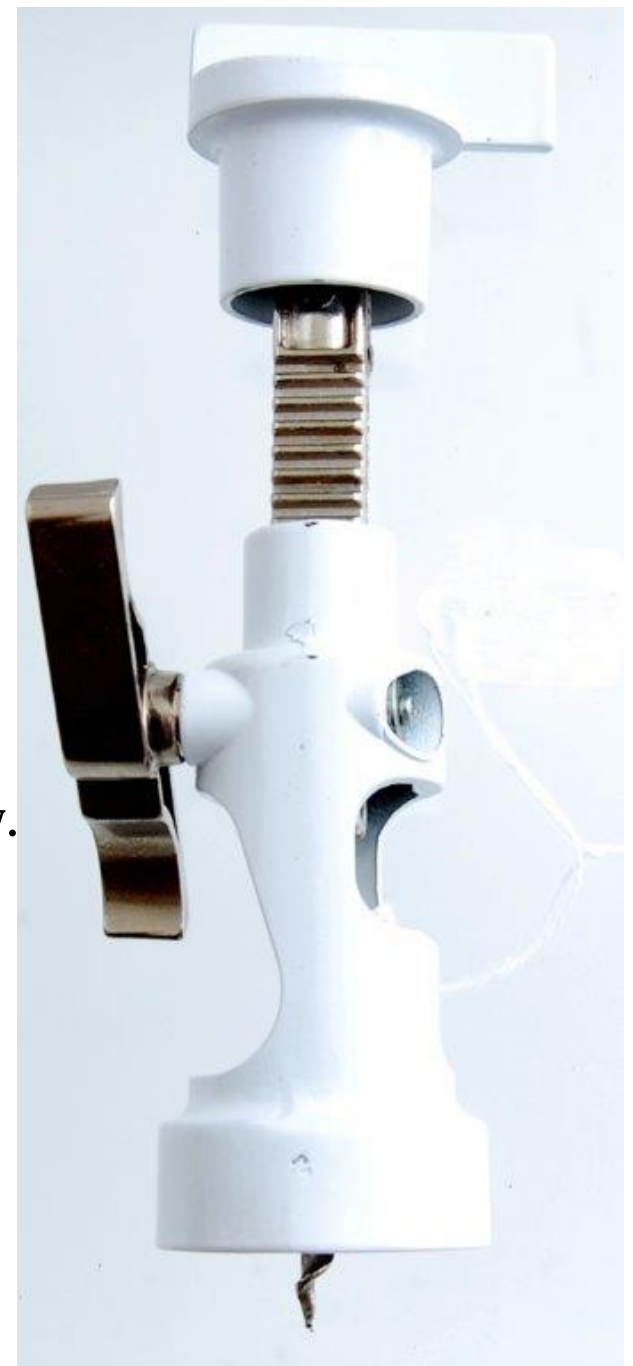

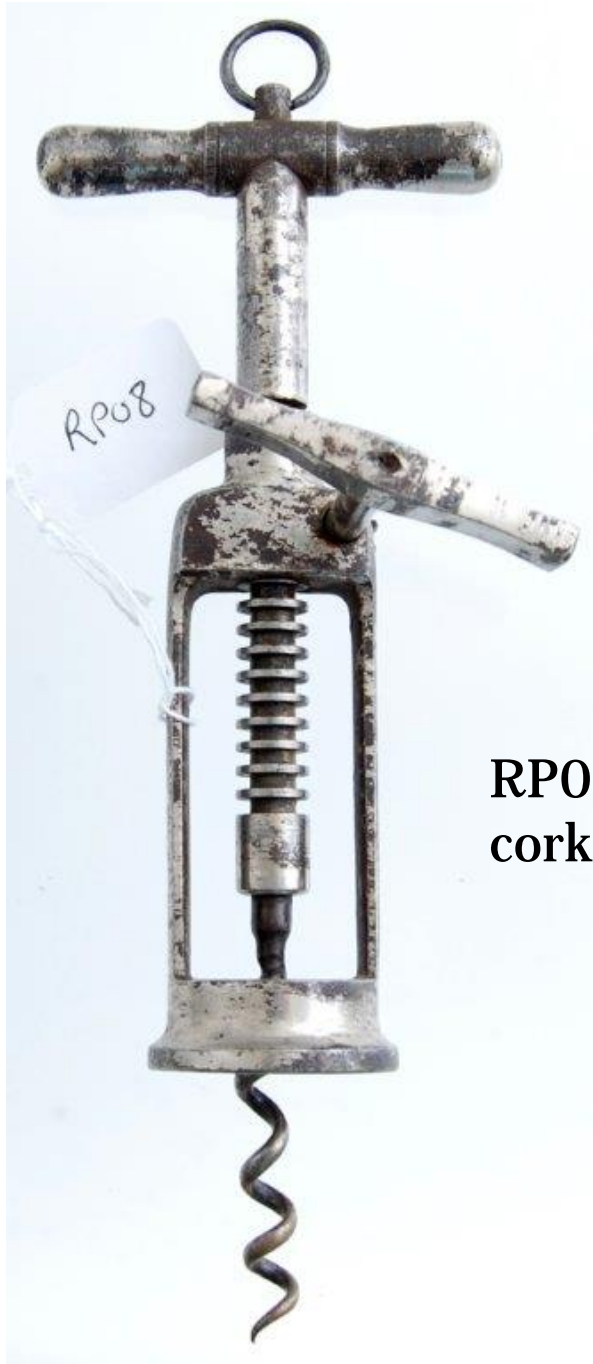
