FF111 Boy and Girl Dancing, 6.5"h., very tall base with eight flower holes, bottom is open, not marked. Light crazing on the children, medium crazing on the base. Tiny chip on boy's chin and a scrape on his nose, BUT the girl's head has been broken off and glued back on again. I could not see this when I bought it, but I can see it now. It's a shame because it is a really cute piece. \$20

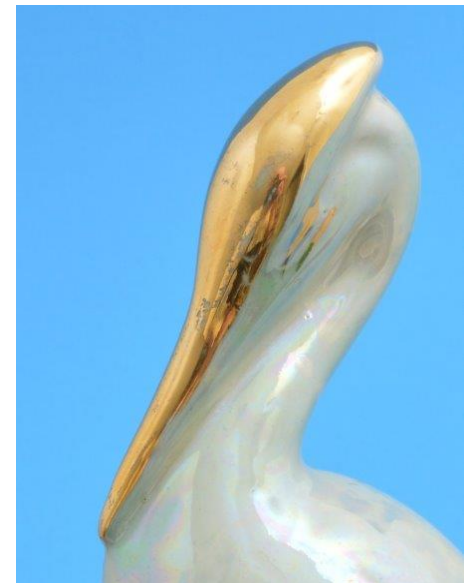


FF111 Boy and Girl Dancing, cont'd.





FF112 Child Riding an Ostrich, 7"h. This piece looks German, but is not marked. Very Good Cond., just one very small chip on stem hole at back. \$35



FF114 Owen China Company. Large Stork, 9.25"h., small center hole in bottom, six flower holes. Iridescent with gold trim. Exc. Cond. \$20



FF115 Stork, matte green pottery, 5 5/8" h. x 2" w. Exc. Cond. \$45



FF116 Brush-McCoy Frog on Leaf Embossed Base, 3.25"h., green glossy glaze, eight flower holes around base, c.1916, not marked. Fine glazing on white chest. Hole on bottom rim, may have been molding bubble. \$50. **SOLD**



FF 117 Brush-McCoy Duck, 4"l. x 2.5"w. x 2.25"h., solid piece, six flower holes in back through to bottom, marked "062," 1915 catalog. Exc. Cond. I must have put felt pads on the bottom of it at some time. \$58



FF118 Brush-McCoy Frog, 4.25"l. x 3.75"w. x 2.5"h., seven holes in back of frog and one large hole on underside, not marked, c.1930. Exc. Cond. \$30. **SOLD**



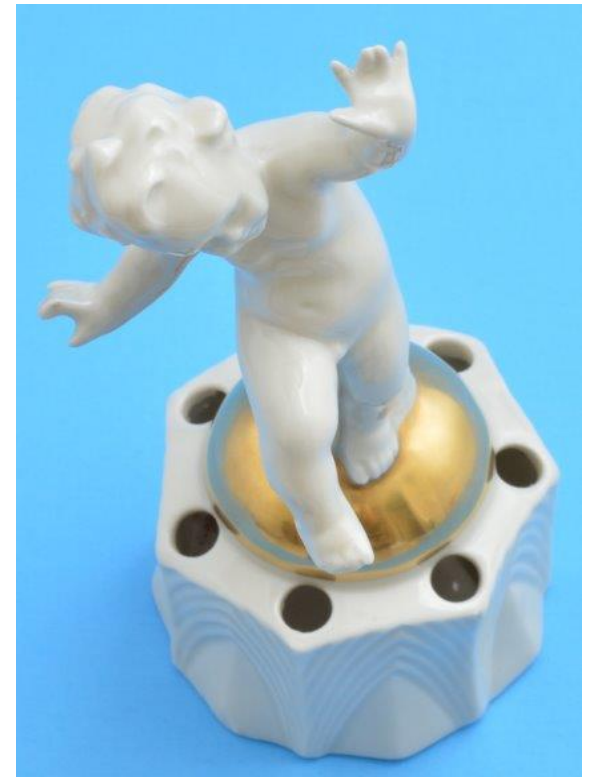
FF 119 Penguin. 4.5" h. x 3.5" w. Ceramic, gray metallic glaze. May be the insert to a bowl. Has anyone ever seen the matching bowl? Exc. Cond. \$12. **SOLD**



FF 120 Child on a Pelican, 4.5"h., seven holes, not marked. Exc. Cond., no chips or cracks. \$25



FF 121 Flower with Butterfly, 2"h., not marked. Same clay body and base as "Child on a Pelican." Exc. Cond. FFC \$15



FF122 Child on Golden Globe, 6.5"h., red ink stamp "Germany " also marked with a Crown on an Eagle with SC on its breast and Kunstporzellan (Art Porcelain). This is the mark of Carl Scheidig, Grafenthal, Thuringia. The mark was used c.1935-1972. Exc. Cond. Has all his fingers and toes. \$47. More pictures on next slide...

FF 125 Cherub with Rabbit Insert and Bowl, 8.5"h. x 6.5"w., bottom of bowl incised "7767." Very good cond. Slight indent (may have been firing bubble) on rim of insert, some crazing. \$92. More pictures on next slide...

FF 126 Young lady with Rose Garland, 7.5"h., double walled base, four digit number impressed on back. German. Exc. Cond. \$37.



FF 127 Boy with Goose. 6.5" h. x 5.5" d. base. Black dot on his left leg and a few lighter dots elsewhere. There are some short cracks on the base interior by holes, but they are due to firing. Heavy. Very good condition. \$35. More pictures on next slide...

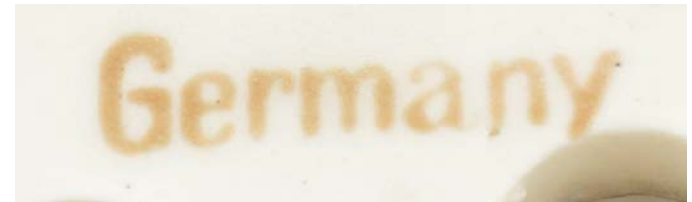
FF 128 White Frog, 4.75"l. x 3.25"w. x 2.5"h.,
seven flower holes in back and one big hole
on the bottom, not marked. Chips on back
feet. Good condition except for back feet.
\$15. **SOLD**



FF 129 German Ballerina, 6"h., impressed on back "1003."
Long faint crack at her feet, faint crazing, two minor chips on
bottom rim. \$12.



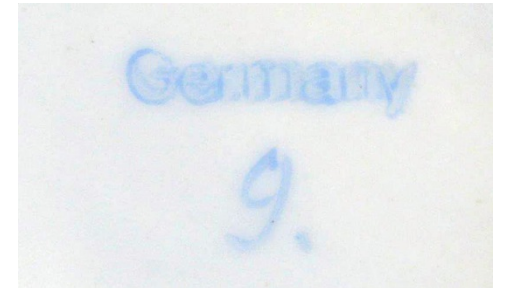
FF 130 Ballerina in Pink, 4"h., stamped in gold "Germany" and has number impressed on base bottom, but hole goes through it. Exc. Cond. \$18.





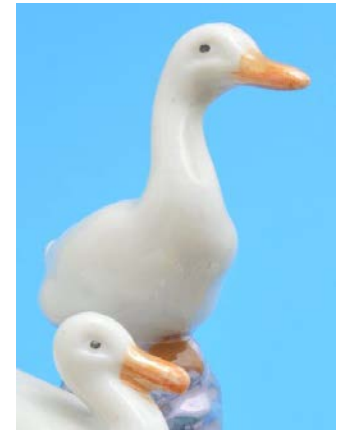
FF 131 Three Children in Costume, 6.25"h., self-contained, five flower holes, stamped in blue "Germany 9." This is one piece; the girls are not an insert. Heavy Porcelain. Exc. Cond. \$90.

FF 132 Two Geese, 5.25"h., stamped in red MADE IN JAPAN. Exc. Cond. \$18.





FF052 Kingfisher, 6"h., there are five stump flower holes, base has two holes, heavy pottery impressed MADE IN JAPAN. Very good condition. \$27.

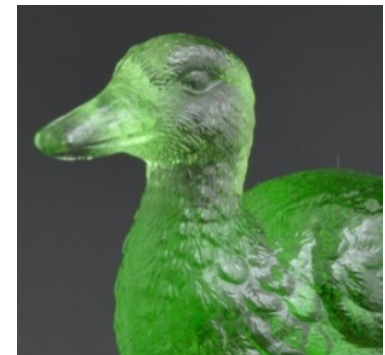
Note: This shape closely resembles the Weller Kingfisher.





FF135 Heisey Duck and floral block #15 in green, 5"h., not marked. The duck is a separate piece that fits into a two-tiered block. Produced from 1927-33. Design Patent #73,280 was granted in 1927 to Ray C. Cobel, Heisey designer. Exc. Cond. Indents on base are for water flow, they are not chips. \$165.
